Tradition Seven: "Every group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions".

### **Suggested Allocation/Distribution of Group & District Funds**

# **Group funds:**

- 1. Rent for meeting place
- 2. Insurance, if applicable
- 3. Literature supply for sale to members
- 4. Tea and/or coffee if provided at meetings
- 5. Group Representatives expenses to attend Assembly in September each year
- 6. District fund –Representative to attend AWSCM and/or Assembly. Amount donated should be based on anticipated costs for DR to travel to AWSCM divided by number of groups in the district.
- 7. Public Outreach It is suggested that each group donate for local PO expenses and projects, support Beginners Meetings and Alateen, if needed
- 8. Bulletin and Forum subscriptions
- 9. Donations to BC/Yukon for expenses related to officers & coordinators work, website costs, delegate expenses for the World Service Conference, and AWSCM & Assembly costs
- 10. Donations to the Al-Anon Information Service or Literature Distribution Centre that serves your District
- 11. Donations to World Service Office

**NOTE**: Group and District expenses should be taken care of first, and then, if possible, contributions can be sent to BC/Yukon Area Assembly, Victoria AlS, Kelowna LDC, Al-Anon Central Services Office, and World Service Office.
